The School's academic year is divided into three semesters. The first begins in August and ends before the Christmas holidays; the second begins in January and ends in May; the third begins in May and ends in mid August.

The standard University academic calendar allows for a one-week mid-semester holiday in the fall, a short Thanksgiving recess, a vacation of approximately three-four weeks between fall and spring semesters, and a one-week mid-semester holiday in the spring. Didactic instruction is also suspended on legal holidays. Students on clinic assignment may not always be released from rotation or fieldwork commitments during these holiday periods.

The School of Pharmacy and Health Professions maintains an All school Calendar that is available online at Calendars and Events. Clinical education courses (rotations, fieldwork and clerkships) are offered on a year-round basis for full-time semester credit and at regular full-time tuition rates (including the summer semester). Offerings in the University's Summer Session are also available. Physical Therapy students must enroll in summer courses in their second and third professional years. Traditional Pharm. D. students must enroll in summer courses in their fourth professional year only. Doctor of Occupational Therapy students must enroll in courses during scheduled summers of the professional program.
